



Case Study: Personal Injury

Cofer v. Safeway (2008)

Joyce Cofer went to her local Safeway store on January 14, 2008. As she was walking along the sidewalk from the can recycling area to the front door her foot struck a bolt sticking out of the sidewalk and she fell to the concrete fracturing her left kneecap and right wrist.

My investigation revealed that someone had removed a bench that had been screwed to the sidewalk, but had left the bolts sticking out of the concrete.

The case settled for \$75,000.
